
## **General Meeting**

The HDBC checking account bank, Bank of the West, was acquired by BMO (Bank of Montreal). Subsequent to the merger, they began charging \$3.00 a month for paper account statements for all customers. Instead of paying the fee, we have online access to the account and statements. They also credited us the fee charged. Credit will be reflected on the October statement.

The HighDesertBirdClub.org domain name was renewed at GoDaddy.com for another year. Cost is \$23.17 and was reimbursed to Jennifer Catron.

Only a few calls were received for late October through mid November.

One caller had a question about finding blood droplets

under her backyard tree. No feathers or fur remnants, or evidence of a nest in the tree. She is worried about her small dogs. After more questions, it sounded like there may be a large owl living in the tree. Owls are nocturnal hunters, cavity dwellers, and really well camouflaged in the tree during the day. The owl will stay as long as there is food source; she said there are a lot of squirrels in the neighborhood. Advised her to not leave her dogs unattended in the yard.

One call was about a surrender which was referred to Birds of a Feather Parrot Rescue of New Mexico.

# Bird Rescue, Foster, and Adoption

A variety of birds are available for adoption at Birds of a Feather Parrot Rescue of New Mexico (BFPR). HDBC is partnering with BFPR to help with receiving, fostering and rehoming pet birds.

Every year, the adoption process is paused from November 1<sup>st</sup> through January 1<sup>st</sup>. This is to discourage the gifting of birds as Christmas or other holiday presents.

If an adoption is already in progress prior to November 1<sup>st</sup>, that adoption can continue to completion.

The rescue is at capacity and a waiting list for surrenders is in place for other than emergency situations.
