Never assume your bird won't fly. Something or someone could frighten it, or a gust of wind catches its wings, and your bird could quickly be airborne and travelling fast.

Some small birds like cockatiels and conures are strong fliers and can fly even if their flight feathers are trimmed. Always be mindful of possible access and escape routes to the great outdoors for your bird.

What's that saying? An ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure.


