Field Trip – Foraging for Piñon Pine Nuts

We're going to try something a little different this year. Harvesting and collecting Piñon pine nuts is a tradition for generations of New Mexicans. Many parrots love piñon pine nuts which are very nutritious and calorie dense.

As we get closer to harvest time, we will have a better idea of when to plan this field trip and where are some of the most abundant places to forage.

If we have enough time and energy afterwards, we may also visit a "you pick" farm where we can pick some fresh fruit and vegetables. Stay tuned for more information as we get closer to October.

Meeting Minutes

Meeting was called to order. Officers, members, and guests were present.

Future meetings and topics were discussed. All agreed to not have a general meeting in July.

Some of these options may require incorporation into the BOAF adoption contract and will take time to add.

Birdy Bingo was the meeting event. Great fun, interesting prizes from the HDBC prize bin, and a small fund-raiser for the bird club.
